Students will add a sound understanding of ICS (NIMS) to their knowledge base. ICS 300 describes how the NIMS Command and Management component supports the management of expanding incidents. It describes the incident/event management process for expanding incidents and supervisors as prescribed by the Incident Command System.

Note - per National Incident Management System (NIMS): All responders who may serve in command or general staff positions must have ICS-100, 200, 300, and 400, as well as IS-700 and IS-800.

***Class Prerequisites:** IS-100 Introduction to Incident Command; IS-200 ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents; IS700-An Introduction to National Incident Management System (NIMS); and IS-800 National Response Framework, An Introduction.
