



Upcoming ICS-300 Class

The Metropolitan Emergency Services Board-Metro Region EMS System is pleased to provide an **ICS 300** training session March 21-23 2023 (**3-day class Tuesday-Thursday**) **0800-1500** presented by Minnesota State Colleges and Universities.

Students will **add to their knowledge base** a sound understanding of ICS (NIMS). ICS 300 describes how the NIMS Command and Management component supports the management of expanding incidents. Describes the incident/event management process for expanding incidents and supervisors as prescribed by the Incident Command System.

Note- per National Incident Management System (NIMS): All responders who may serve in command or general staff positions must have ICS-100, 200, 300, and 400 as well as IS-700 and IS-800.

***Prerequisites:** IS-100 Introduction to Incident Command; IS-200 ICS for Single Resources and Initial Action Incidents; IS700-An Introduction to National Incident Management System (NIMS); and IS-800 National Response Framework, An Introduction.
