- Unit ID
- Age/Gender
- Chief Complaint
- ETA
- Patient Acuity/Color

 Red alerts: Cardiac arrest, ECMO, Medical, STEMI, Stroke, Trauma/TTA

Red Patients Only

Initial report including...

- Full set of Vital Signs
- History, interventions, response to treatment
- Mechanism of Injury
- GCS
- Airway
- EKG findings (initial and current)
- ROSC
- Last known well
- Blood Glucose

Patient Acuity

Red Medical, Red Trauma/TTA, Critical (requires immediate treatment/transport)
Yellow (Stable but requires observation)
Green (Triage Appropriate)

Pertinent Info

Specialty needs

- Hold status (in custody)
- Security needed
- ETOH
- Interpreter
- Isolation needs
- Transfer (provide patient initials)

MRCC Talkgroups

- West MRCC 1 and 2
- SMRCC Statewide
- STAC ECMO
- ** Wait for MRCC to acknowledge report before switching talkgroups.
- **Major incidents consider identification

EMS COMMAND QUICK GUIDE

INITIAL RADIO REPORT

- Conditions Describe the scene, nature of incident, # of pts, etc.
- <u>Actions</u> "Investigating", "Triaging", etc.
- <u>N</u>eeds Resources/EMS Plan, Medical Director, etc. Provide command location, staging location, ingress/egress routes.

Example:

[agency unit] arriving on a [describe what you see], we will be [state actions], please start a [plan level or specific resources], [agency unit] will have EMS Command.

EMS COMMAND FUNCTIONS

- Triage of patients (see below).
- Consider Divisions/ Groups.
- Establish a UNIFIED COMMAND.
- Utilize tactical & Interop talkgroups.
- Notify MRCC of the incident and number of patients for a system advisory.
- Establish and communicate EMS transport and staging areas.
- Assign units in the model: TASK to be accomplished, LOCATION to complete the task, and OBJECTIVE of each task.

Red Medical, Red Trauma/TTA, Critical (requires immediate treatment/transport)
Yellow (Stable but requires observation)
Green (Triage Appropriate)

RESOURCES

- Order resources as needed.
- Notify MRCC of regional recourse needs.
- EMS Plan 1 4 Ambulances, 1 Command, MNTRAC EMS System Advisory (Initial)
- EMS Plan 2 4 Ambulances, 2 Command, System Medical Director (Additional)
- EMS Plan 3 4 Ambulances, 2 Command, EMS Region MIR Bus (Additional)
