1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m by MMRTAC Palei.

2. Roll Call

Roll call occurred.

3. Approval of Agenda

4. Approval of Minutes of Previous Meeting

5. Discussion Items

a. STAC/RTAC

Maria gave an update on the stack. 5 STAC seats will be open for those interested. The posting for the positions should be in mid-October on the Secretary of State website. The next meeting is September 15, 2026. A review of the RTAC report from the agenda.

b. TQIP Collaboration

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Nothing to update. The group will review some of the data after the meeting.

c. Geriatric Workgroup

The workgroup is at a pause.

d. PEDS Workgroup

The peds group met. Working on a musculoskeletal resource. The hope is to bring it to the next meeting as a draft. Will work on the other area for update. Finally, adding a TQUIP collaborative tie to the Peds.

e. Trauma/ECMO

Discussion on the next level of the process for inpatient/ ICU as not all patients coming through the ED. Partner at the beginning when it comes to ongoing surgical needs. Dr. Simpson (HCMC) gave a perspective and concerns on triage and how it can impact trauma care. Discussion on the original concern brought up to the group and how the new trauma/ECMO procedure. Suggestion on having a subgroup to look at issues when they arise so the MMRTAC committee can stay ahead of potential issues.

f. Ophthalmology Update

A short discussion on how other agencies are handling these patients as it is a rare occurrence and a limited number of retinal specialists.

g. MDH Grant

MDH awarded the MMRTAC \$8,000 in grant funds to be used towards tourniquets. The tourniquets have been ordered in preparation for the state fair and other Stop the Bleed events. Reach out to Hayes if tourniquets are needed.

h. Website Update
